CURRICULUM

The Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) was introduced in the Undergraduate (UG) and Postgraduate (PG) programmes in Tamil Nadu from the Education (TANSICHE) implemented uniform curriculum across all universities in the state from the academic year 2023-2024. Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, in compliance with TANSICHE's regulations, made significant revisions to the curriculum for the first year UG and PG students.

First Year:

Part I: Language, Part II: General English, Part III: Core Courses/Elective Courses (Generic / Discipline Specific), Part IV: Skill Enhancement Courses Environmental Studies / Value Education.

Third Year :

Major papers / A common Personality Development Paper, Project / Field Study. Mandatory completion of a course under the "Nan Mudhalvan Scheme" was introduced by the Government of Tamil Nadu for the UG students from the academic year 2022-2023.

PG Programmes:

The curriculum primarily consists of Core Courses, Elective Courses and Project Work / Internship.

Alumini Engagement

Muslim Arts College Alumni Association has successfully organized various events and raised significant funds for the institution's welfare. Recently, the association has become a registered body, with the registration number:

SRG/Kaniyakumari/81/2023 in which the alumni increasingly contribute their time and resources, often enlisting the support of their friends. Our active and registered Alumni Association is known as the MAC Alumni Association. Graduates are encouraged to remain engaged with the institution and support their successors.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The college provides students with a whole range of Co-Curricular and Extra - Curricular activities to make their campus life interesting and meaningful and mould them into matured persons.

1. COURSE REQUIREMENT :

a) National Cadet Crops (N.C.C) (Company III)

The 11/9 battalion company of the NCC has a strength of 104 Cadets (with Head Quarters at Nagercoil). The mixed battalion (boys and girls) has been functioning for the last five years. The aims of the N.C.C. are:

i) To develop qualities of character, courage, comradeship, discipline, leadership, secular outlook, spirit of adventure and sportsmanship and the deals of selfless service among the youth to make them useful citizens.

ii) To create a human resource of organized, trained and motivated youth, to provide leadership in all walks of life including the armed forces and to make them always available for the service of the nation.

The tenure of N.C.C. training is normally two years. In cases of exceptional cadets, it may be extended to one more year. The N.C.C. training consists of drill with or without arms, weapon training, map reading, bayoner-fighting, range firing with rifle and light machine gun, elementary military field tactics, study of army organization and allied subjects. Selected cadets will have the privilege of attending Annual Training Camp, Summer Training Camp, Advanced Leadership Training Camp, Republic Day Parade, Mountaineering Courses and Attachment to Army Units.

There will be 40 parades per year. Attendance is compulsory for all parades. Punctuality, good turn out and active disciplined participation are expected from all cadets.

The cadets will have the chance of appearing for B and C Certificate examinations according to the proficiency attained.

(b) National Service Scheme - N.S.S.

There are three N.S.S. units Unit Nos. 71, 80 & 137 functioning under the Youth Welfare Department of the Manonmaniam Sundaranar University. The authorized strength is 100 in each unit. N.S.S. activities have been divided into two major groups, namely Regular Activities and Special Camping programme. Under regular activities students undertake various programmes in the adopted villages, College campuses and urban slums during weekends or after college hours. Duration of these services is 120 hours per year. The motto of the National Service Scheme is “NOT ME BUT YOU”.

The aims of the N.S.S. are:

1. To work with and among people.
2. To engage in creative and constructive social action.
3. To make National Service more meaningful and purposeful and to integrate the same with curriculum.
4. To provide an opportunity to the students to have a sense of participation in Nation - Building tasks.
5. To inculcate the spirit of National consciousness in the minds of the students.

Extension Service-Village adoption:

As a part of the extension activities of the college, we have adopted the Village Kattuva, Aarukani, near Pathukani. It is socially and economically a very backward Village. The objectives in adopting these village are:

- *To conduct community development programmes.
- *To encourage adult education and literacy programmes.
- *To conduct environmental awareness programmes

- *To conduct social work camps with the help of the N.G.Os,
- *To make the people aware of Govt. welfare schemes.
- *To have health and hygiene awareness camps.
- *To give education to the local people on numerous rights
- *To create awareness among the people about consumer problems.

Enrolment:

Students of degree classes with good physique and a positive attitude and who have the liking to work with and for the underprivileged alone will be enrolled. They must be fully aware of the objectives and the responsibilities. Enrolments will be completed before 1st August.

There shall be a college level N.S.S. Committee under the Chairmanship of the Principal with a Programme Officer as Convenor. The Committee may consist of not more than 10 and shall include some senior members of staff, students and leading citizens interested in the scheme. This Advisory Committee may chalk out the programmes for the year. A minute book for recording the proceedings of the advisory committee should be maintained.

The N.S.S. programme officers will give further details regarding the projects and programmes.

(c) Physical Education:

There are facilities for the following games, Foot Ball, Volley Ball, Tennis, Shuttle Cock, Ball Badminton, Cricket, Tennikoit and Throw Ball. Training is given for all athletic events. There are facilities for indoor games like Table-Tennis, Chess and Caroms. Intra-mural tournaments are conducted by the College. Inter-collegiate tournaments are organized by the University. The college team also participates in the events conducted by other organizations locally and at the district level.

Students of all classes with aptitude and interest are always welcome to use the facilities for sports and games in the college. Further particulars and details will be available from the concerned department from time to time.

(d) RRC:

The Red Ribbon Club is a voluntary on-campus intervention programme for students. The programme organized by RRC addresses the knowledge, attitude and behaviour of the youths in the interrelated areas of Voluntary Blood Donation, HIV & AIDS, as demanded by their age, environment and lifestyle. The RRC (Red Ribbon Club) consists of 50 students with the coordination of NSS in the college.

The college has a Red Ribbon Club. The Red Ribbon Club has been the result of the movement started by the Government of India in schools and colleges through which, students will spread awareness over HIV/AIDS. This is a voluntary program and is conducted in collaboration with NSS Program Officer and volunteers.

Objectives of RRC

To create awareness about HIV infection and its aftermath

To induce among the youth a spirit to help and support people living with HIV/AIDS

To help create awareness among youth about reducing stigma and discrimination against HIV/AIDS infected people

To promote the habit of voluntary blood donation among the youth

To be a platform to motivate youth and build their capacity as peer educators and help them develop their skills of leadership and team building and thereby guide them to be change makers.

(b) YRC:

The Youth Red Cross of Muslim Arts College is one of the active clubs of the college which has the motto to Serve Humanity. All the students of the college are the members of YRC. The YRC has observed and celebrated the following days of International days of importance related to Youth Red Cross. They are

- Geneva Convention
- Day World
- Student's Day
- World Food Day
- Vigilance Awareness Week Celebration

Further, usual blood identification and blood donations camps were organised. Prospectus donors were identified and suggested whenever there is a need.
