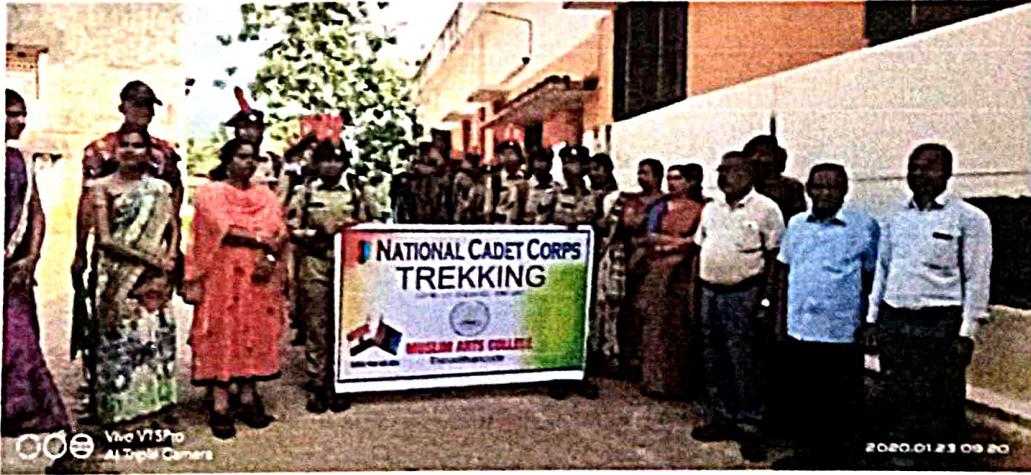
TREKKING

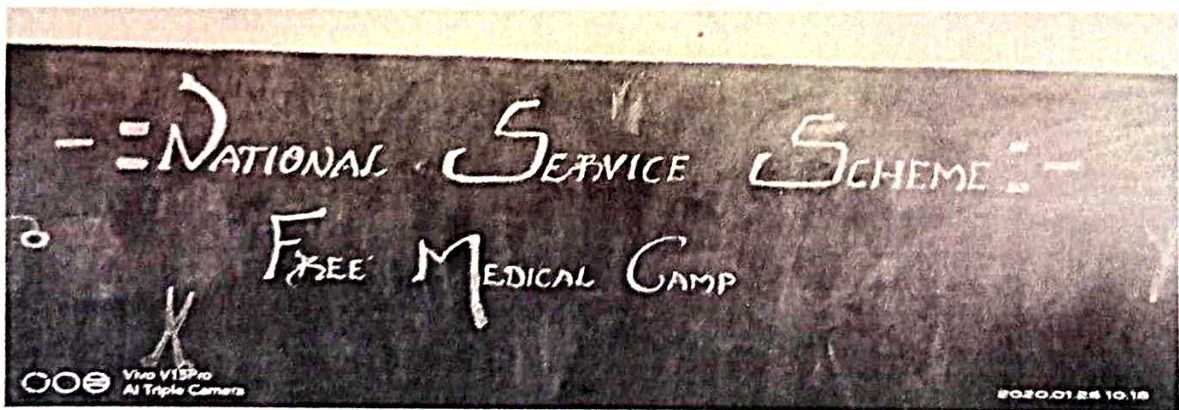

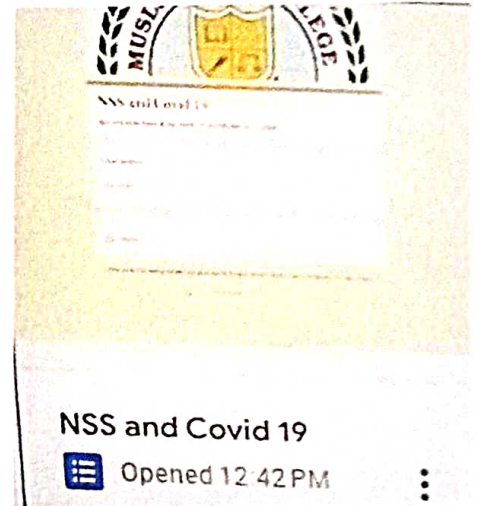
