Anti - Corruption Day Report - 2022

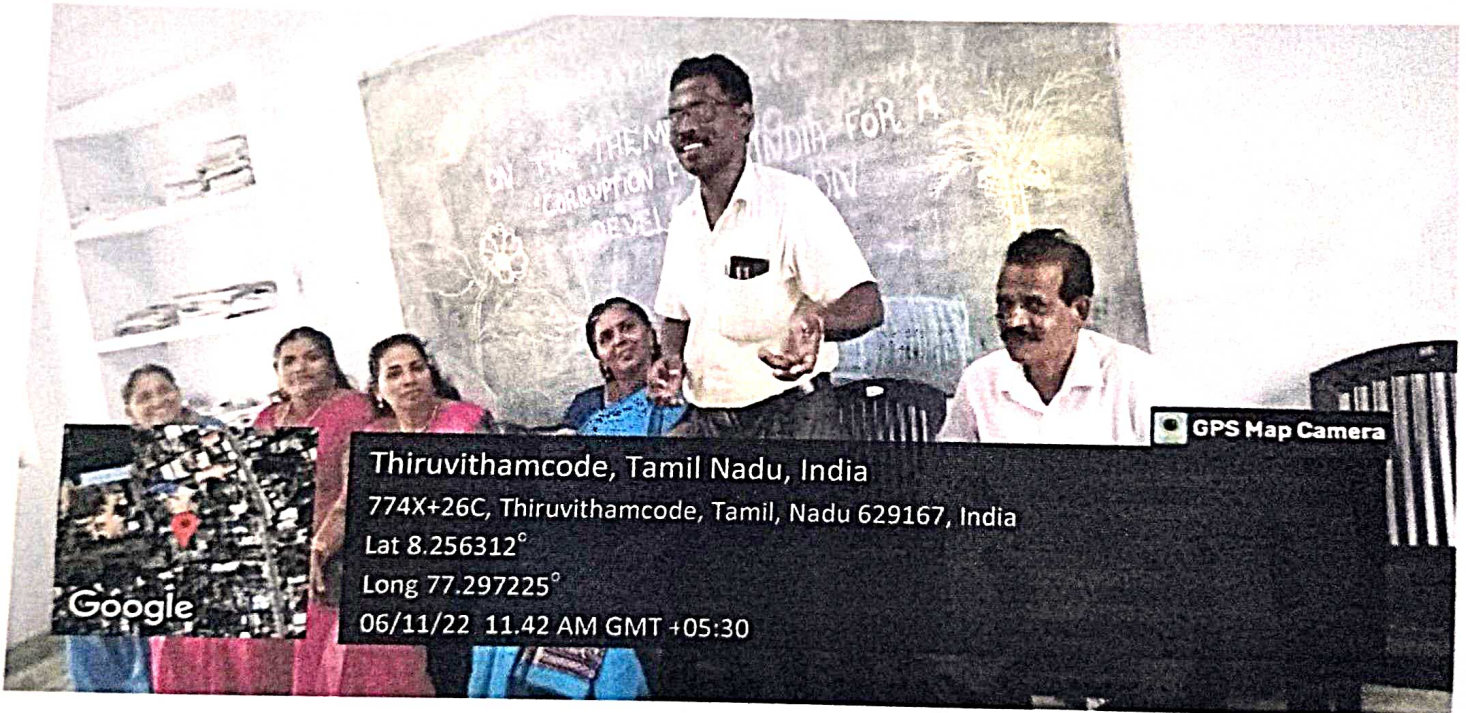

Visit to International Cancer Centre, Neyyoor

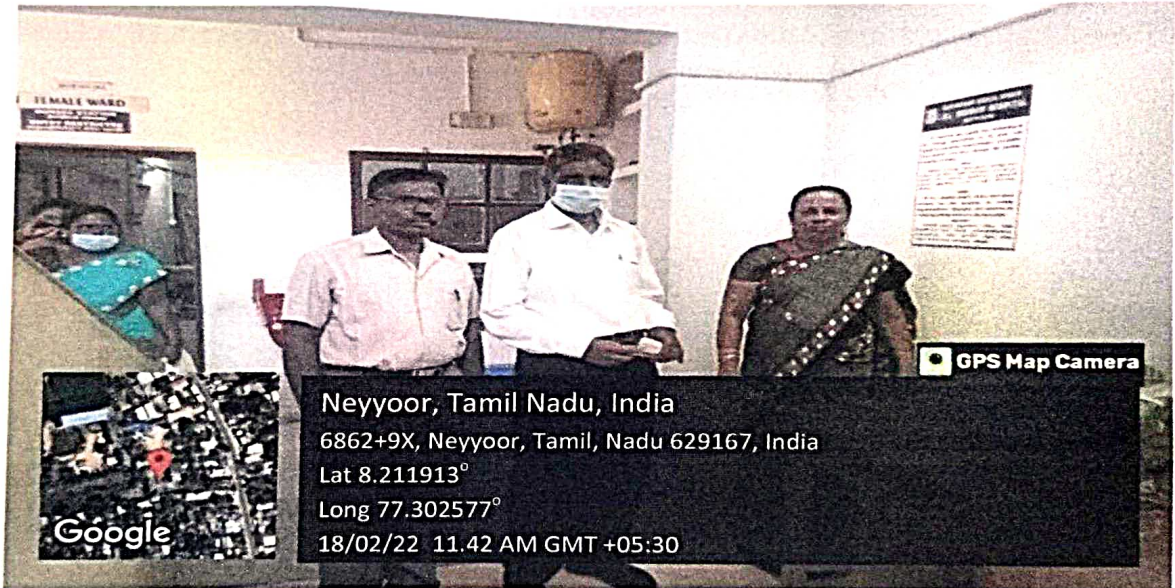
Name of the Activity : Visit to International Cancer Centre




