First International Conference 13-10-2021

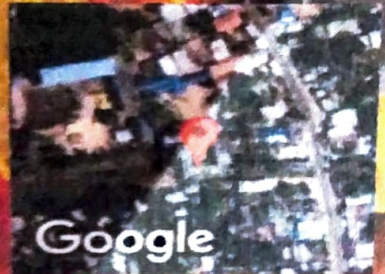
