So the college was founded at Madavalayam in 1982 after seeking permission from the government. The university granted affiliation in 1984. Then the college was shifted from Madavalayam to Thiruvithancode in a large beautiful existing Jalal Building. Now the prestigious institution is functioning with 23 UG departments, 16 PG departments and 8 research centers.

**Department of History**

History has been offered as one of the subjects of learning right from the beginning of the college. The department of history emerged as a full-fledged faculty importing the degree of Bachelor of Arts in History in the year 1984-1985 and was raised to the status of a Post Graduate Department in 2014. The inaugural function was started at 9.45 am with Tamil Thaivazhthu. The participants of the function welcomed by HOD of History Dr.T.G. Seema Gopal. The presidential address was given by Lion. Dr. H. Mohamed Ali secretary and correspondence of our college. The principal Dr. G. Edwin Sheela, Mr. M. Afzal Fayaz Joint Secretary and Dr. A. Mohamed Siddique felicitated. The Chief Guest address was given by Dr. S. Regi, Assistant Professor, Department of History, Holy Cross College(Autonomous), Nagercoil.

In this seminar students from our department and other department students of our college participated. More than 97 students and faculty members from other colleges participated. The Technical section was handled by Resource Person Dr. S. Regi.

She mentioned about the voting rights for women in India Asia and Europe. In India before independence voting right was not given to all. Only graduate high caste people and land lords were given voting right. In India many women leaders demanded the government for voting rights. Sarojini Naidu and 14 leading women for demand of voting right. The British parliament passed the representation of the people Act of 1918. After Independence franchise was given to irrespective of caste and community. So she requested the male and female students to cast your vote during the time of election.

Vote of thanks was given by Dr. T.S. Sasikala, Assistant Professor. of History. The programme ended with National Anthem.
