Profile of the College

Muslim Arts College aims at giving quality education to develop the personality of the students. The college aims at producing worthy citizens.

The college was started in 1982 by the Muslim Educational Society, with B.Com., B.A. History and B.Sc. Mathematics. Madurai Kamaraj University granted affiliation to the courses in 1984. Gradually other major courses in U.G and P.G. were introduced. With the establishment of Manonmaniam Sundaranar University in 1990, the college was affiliated to this University. The college, which is a co-educational institution, has in its roll 1926 students, of whom 1040 are girls and 886 are boys. We have 170 teaching staff and 64 Non-teaching staff. The vision of the College is to provide quality education and become a Centre of Excellence for Higher Education.

MAC Research Forum

Research being the soul of higher education, we have seen an upswing in research pursuits of not just the faculty of our institution, but also our Scholars. Dr.T.Kumaran is the Research Coordinator of our Research Centres. Among the teachers in 8 Research

Centres 26 of them are approved as research guides by the Manonmaniam Sundaranar University. About 30 Ph.D Scholars have been granted awards, and out of which 13 scholars received their degree during this academic year. In this academic year 28 scholars have submitted their Thesis and have been waiting for viva-voce. 115 Ph.D scholars are doing research works in their respective disciplines. Our Research Supervisors and Scholars published articles in 92 National & International journals and they are also presented 86 papers at national and international seminars and conferences. With a special interest in the area of research, our Secretary had planned to start a Nodal Research centre and it has been now flourished as this "MAC Research Forum." The MAC Research forum hosted a national conference on Multidisciplinary Research Ethics on 4th & 5th September 2023. One hundred and forty five experts and scholars from across the country participated and presented their research papers. To encourage research spirit among the faculty and students, we have come up with our own research journal which is about to release soon.

Merit Scholarship

Mohamed Ahsan S, B.Com. C.S. student, who got the highest mark in the University Examinations received the merit scholarship of Rs.1000/- in memory of M.S. Mohideen Malik Mohamed, founder of Jalal Buildings, where our college is situated.

The Part I Arabic Student M. Fareena Beevi of B.Sc. Maths who secured the highest mark is provided with merit scholarship of Rs.750/- and A. Fathima Afra and U.F. Waff of BCA who secured second highest marks are also given merit scholarship of Rs.375/- each.

Library

To enhance the retrieval of Technological Communication, N-List INFLIBNET is installed in our library and utilized by maximum users. Our college Library is now fully computerized. About 23057 books of different disciplines are available in the Library. This year new collections of books, national & international journals, magazines have been added to our library and we have also added 400 books to the stock. Moreover, all the departments have their own Department Library which amounts to 10,262 and in total about 33,719 books are now available in our college.
